Acts 1:6-8 The Question

- 6So when they had come together, they were asking Him, saying, <u>"Lord, is it at this time You are</u> restoring the kingdom to Israel?"
- 7He said to them, "It is not for you to know times or epochs which the Father has fixed by His own authority;
- 8but you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be My witnesses both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth."

- Jesus doesn't rebuke them
- He doesn't correct them
- He just says you can't know when

Acts 1:9-11 The Answer

- And after He had said these things,
- He was lifted up
- while they were looking on,
- and a cloud received Him out of their sight.
- And as they were gazing intently into the sky while He was going, behold, two men in white clothing stood beside them. They also said, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking into the sky?
- This Jesus, who has been taken up from you into heaven, will come in just the same way as you have watched Him go into heaven."

Acts 1:9-11 Prophecy of Second Coming

- And after He had said these things,
- He was lifted up
- while they were looking on,
- and a cloud received Him out of their sight.
- And as they were gazing intently into the sky while He was going, behold, two men in white clothing stood beside them. They also said, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking into the sky?

- Jesus will return just as he went up:
 - Visible from earth
 - In a cloud
 - With angels

Romans 9 vs. 6-8

- 6But it is not as though the word of God has failed For they are not all Israel who are descended from Israel;
 - 7 nor are they all children because they are Abraham's descendants, but: "THROUGH ISAAC YOUR DESCENDANTS WILL BE NAMED."
- 8That is, it is not the children of the flesh who are children of God, but the children of the promise are regarded as descendants.

Romans 9 vs. 3-5

- 3For I could wish that I myself were accursed, separated from Christ for the sake of my brethren, my kinsmen according to the flesh,
- 4 who are Israelites, to whom belongs the adoption as sons, and the glory and the covenants and the giving of the Law and the temple service and the promises,
- 5whose are the fathers, and from whom is the Christ according to the flesh, who is over all, God blessed forever. Amen.

- Israel = Ethnic Israel
- To Israel belongs the "Temple Service"?

Romans 9 vs. 27, 31

- Romans 9:27
 Isaiah cries out concerning
 Israel, "THOUGH THE NUMBER
 OF THE SONS OF ISRAEL BE
 LIKE THE SAND OF THE SEA, IT
 IS THE REMNANT THAT WILL BE
 SAVED;
- Israel Not = the Church
- Remnant is subset of Israel, not Gentiles

 Romans 9:31
 <u>but Israel, pursuing a law of</u> <u>righteousness, did not arrive at</u> <u>that law</u>.

Romans 10 vs. 19, 21

 Romans 10:19
 But I say, surely <u>Israel did not</u> <u>know</u>, did they? First Moses says," I WILL MAKE YOU JEALOUS BY THAT WHICH IS NOT A NATION, BY A NATION WITHOUT UNDERSTANDING WILL I ANGER YOU."
 Israel <u>not</u>
 = Church

Romans 10:21
 But as for Israel He says, "ALL
 THE DAY LONG I HAVE
 STRETCHED OUT MY HANDS
 TO A DISOBEDIENT AND
 OBSTINATE PEOPLE."

Romans 11 vs. 1

- I say then, God has not rejected His people, has He? May it never be! For I too am an Israelite, <u>a descendant of</u> <u>Abraham, of the</u> <u>tribe of Benjamin.</u>
- "Israel" Refers to ethnic Israel
 - His People =
 - Israel =
 - Descendants of Abraham
 - of tribe of Benjamin

Romans 11 vs 2-3

- 2God has not rejected His people whom He foreknew Or do you not know what the Scripture says in the passage about Elijah, how he pleads with God against Israel?
- 3"Lord, THEY HAVE KILLED YOUR PROPHETS, THEY HAVE TORN DOWN YOUR ALTARS, AND I ALONE AM LEFT, AND THEY ARE SEEKING MY LIFE."

 "Israel" does not refer to the
 Church Paul Descendant of Abraham

His People Not Rejected

Romans 11 vs 4-5

- 4But what is the divine response to him? "I HAVE KEPT for Myself SEVEN THOUSAND MEN WHO HAVE NOT BOWED THE KNEE TO BAAL."
- 5In the same way then, there has also come to be at the present time a remnant according to God's gracious choice.

The Remnant
is a Subset
of Ethnic
Israel, not
the Church

Romans 11 vs 6-7

- 6 But if it is by grace, it is no longer on the basis of works, otherwise grace is no longer grace.
- 7 What then? What
 Israel is seeking, it has
 not obtained, but those
 who were chosen
 obtained it, and the rest
 were hardened;

- "Israel" is not the Church.
- Israel has two subsets, remnant and hardened rest.
- Israel =
 - Chosen + Hardened

Romans 11 vs 8-10

- 8just as it is written,
 "GOD GAVE THEM A SPIRIT OF STUPOR,
 EYES TO SEE NOT AND EARS TO HEAR NOT,
 DOWN TO THIS VERY DAY."
- 9And David says, "LET THEIR TABLE BECOME A SNARE AND A TRAP, AND A STUMBLING BLOCK AND A RETRIBUTION TO THEM. 10" LET THEIR EYES BE DARKENED TO SEE NOT, AND BEND THEIR BACKS FOREVER."

 Them = The "rest" of Ethnic Israel that has been hardened

Romans 11 vs 11-15

- 111 say then, they did not stumble so as to fall, did they? May it never be! But by their transgression salvation has come to the <u>Gentiles</u>, to)make them jealous.
- 12Now if their transgression is riches for the <u>world</u> and their failure is riches for the <u>Gentiles</u>, how much more will their fulfillment be!
- 13But <u>I am speaking to you who are</u> <u>Gentiles.</u> Inasmuch then as I am an apostic of <u>Gentiles</u>, I magnify my ministry,
- 14if somehow I might move to jealousy <u>my</u> <u>fellow countrymen</u> and save some of them.
- 15For if their rejection is the reconciliation of the <u>world</u>, what will their acceptance be but life from the dead?

- They = Hardened rest
- Hardened Rest is opposite of
 - Gentiles
 - The World
- Israel = Paul's
 fellow countrymen
 - Some of them will be saved
 - Paul speaking to Gentile, not Jewish members of Church

Romans 11 vs 16-18

- 16If the first piece of dough is holy, the lump is also; and if the root is holy, the branches are too.
- 17But if some of the branches were broken off, and <u>you</u>, being a wild olive, were grafted in among them and became partaker with them of the rich root of the olive tree,
- 18do not be arrogant toward the branches; but if <u>you</u> are arrogant, remember that it is not <u>you</u> who supports the root, but the root supports you.

- First piece = Abram/ Israel
- Lump = Fellow Countrymen
- Root = Abram/Israel
- Branches = Fellow Countrymen
- Some Branches Cut Off = Hardened Rest
- You = Gentile members of Church

Romans 11 vs 19-22

- 19You will say then, "Branches were broken off so that I might be grafted in."
- 20Quite right, they were broken off for their unbelief, but you stand by your faith Do not be conceited, but fear;
- 21for if God did not spare the natural branches, He will not spare <u>you</u>, either
- 22Behold then the kindness and severity of God; to those who fell, severity, but to <u>you</u>, God's kindness, if <u>you</u> continue in His kindness; otherwise you also will be cut off.

- Hardened Jews = Branches broken off
- Gentiles = Branches grafted in
 - Gentiles could be cut off, so doesn't refer to Church.

Romans 11 vs 23-24

- 23And they also, if they do not continue in their unbelief, will be grafted in, for God is able to graft them in again.
- 24For if <u>you</u> were cut off from what is by nature a wild olive tree, and were grafted contrary to nature into a cultivated olive tree, how much more will these who are the natural branches be grafted into their own olive tree?

 Israel's "natural" branches (= hardened rest") may be restored to "their own tree" SO

• Tree does not = the church

Romans 11 vs 25

- 25For I do not want you, brethren, to be uninformed of this <u>mystery</u>--so that you will not be wise in your own estimation--that a partial hardening has happened to Israel until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in;
- Ethnic Israel partially hardened for a time
- Israel
 cannot = the
 Church

Romans 11 vs 26-27

- 26and so all Israel will be saved; just as it is written, "(THE **DELIVERER WILL** COME FROM ZION, HE WILL REMOVE **UNGODLINESS FROM** JACOB." 27"THIS IS MY **COVENANT WITH** THEM, WHEN I TAKE AWAY THEIR SINS."
- all ethnic Israel will have its branches grafted back in
 - Ungodliness removed
 - Sins taken away
- Context forbids the meaning of "Spiritual Israel" i.e. the church

Romans 11 vs. 28-29

- 28From the standpoint of the gospel they are enemies for your sake, but from the standpoint of God's choice they are beloved for the sake of the fathers;
- 29for the <u>gifts and the calling</u> of God are irrevocable.

- Israel cannot =
 the Church
- Israel must mean
 Ethnic Israel
- Ethnic Israel still beloved
- God's calling of Ethnic Israel is irrevocable

Romans 11 vs. 30-31

- 30For just as you once were disobedient to God, but now have been shown mercy because of their disobedience,
- 31so these also now have been disobedient, that because of the mercy shown to you they also may now be shown mercy.

 If God can save Gentiles, he can save ethnic Jews too.

Paul's Use of "Israel" Corinthians

1 Corinthians 10:18 Look at the nation Israel; are not those who eat the sacrifices sharers in the altar?

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- 2 Corinthians 3:7 But if the ministry of death, in letters engraved on stones, came with glory, so that the sons of Israel could not look intently at the face of Moses because of the glory of his face, fading as it was,
- 2 Corinthians 3:13 and are not like Moses, who used to put a veil over his face so that the sons of Israel would not look intently at the end of what was fading away.
- 2 Corinthians 11:22 <u>Are they Hebrews? So am I Are they Israelites? So am I Are they</u> <u>descendants of Abraham? So am I.</u>

Paul's Use of "Israel" Galations, Ephesians & Philipians

Galatians 6:16

And those who will walk by this rule, peace and mercy be upon them, and upon the **Israel** of God.

Ephesians 2:12

remember that you were at that time separate from Christ, *excluded from the commonwealth of Israel*, and strangers to the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world.

Philippians 3:5
 <u>circumcised the eighth day, of the nation of Israel, of</u>

 <u>the tribe of Benjamin, a Hebrew of Hebrews; as to</u>
 <u>the Law, a Pharisee;</u>
